Terms of trade

20240408 For purpose of this document: Guests are referred to as Participants. The term 'Tour Operator' comprises of travel agents, tour operators and ITOs. GuideGunnar is referred to as 'GuideGunnar', 'Organiser' and 'Guide'.

Safety and Security

Your guide's responsibility

In order to take care of the tour's safety and security, be it winter- or summer tours, GuideGunnar apply the 1:8 model. The 1:8 model sees to that there is one guide per 8 guests. That is, when the number of participants will be more than 8, there will be a second guide joining the tour. In the Back to Nature activities, like skiing, snow-shoeing, walking or hiking, we have, also as a quality measure, set an upper limit of 12 guests participating.

All GuideGunnar Guides are experienced in and passionate about outdoor activities and the wild. They hold required, up to date knowledge of first aid and are able to handle a variety of situations in different weather conditions. The guides always bring the necessary safety and security equipment.

GuideGunnar Guides are also responsible for ensuring that everyone in the group is sufficiently equipped and is in a condition to join the tours. If it is the opinion of the guide that someone is not fit to follow a particular tour, it is the guide's full responsibility to deny this person the right to participate.

Participants' responsibility

GuideGunnar is actively working to ensure the tour will be carried out in the safest way possible. However, it is essential that each participant is covered by an insurance policy of their own.

Parents and other superiors who guarantee for children, are obliged to make sure that everyone in their company is in adequate physical shape to participate in the chosen program.

Each participant is obliged to stay with the tour group for the duration of the tour and to follow the guide's instructions at all times.



By registering for a tour, participants agree to abide by the guide's instructions and to accept the guide's decisions. This also applies should the opinion of the guide be that someone is not fit to follow a particular tour. It is the guide's full responsibility to deny this person the right to participate and it is the participant's obligation to accept the guide's decision.

Participants or their Tour Operator is responsible for providing GuideGunnar with the participants' mobile (cell) phone number and name and address of their accommodation in Tromsø. This is important in case GuideGunnar cancels the tour due to poor weather and difficult driving conditions. Furthermore, Participants or their Tour Operator is required to provide, at the time of booking, all tour participants' full name, year of birth and country as per travel documentation.

Insurance

GuideGunnar is insured through Gjensidige. The insurance covers injuries and damages to persons and objects.

GuideGunnar is a member of the Norwegian Travel Guarantee Fund through which and pursuant to the Package Tours Act of Norway, the tour organiser is covering its obligation to refund monies paid by the consumer in the event of the organiser's insolvency. GuideGunnar requires that each participant is responsible for obtaining and holding a current, personal insurance policy of their own.

Bookings

For tours lasting more than one day, bookings are accepted no later than 30 days before the tour date. For day programs, bookings are accepted up until the day before the tour date. For GuideGunnar's Aurora Chase tours, bookings are accepted up until 6 pm the same day tour starts. All bookings require a GuideGunnar confirmation of availability and are bound by conditions of payment.

Payments

Two payment options

- Card payment through the online booking platform
- Bank to bank funds transfer, quoting the tour booking ID upon transfer of funds. Account details at end of this document.

Conditions of payment

Day tours

Tour Operators are invoiced by the end of the month of the tour date month, comprising of all bookings for tours run that month. Invoice is payable by bank to bank funds transfer upon receipt.



Tour Operators in their first year of contract with GuideGunnar, are required to pay at the time of booking. A discount code qual the commission rate will deduct Tour Operators' commission fee before payment processing takes place.

For tours lasting more than one day

If booking takes place less than 30 days before the tour date, the Tour Operator is invoiced the full tour fee, payable in full by card payment or by bank to bank funds transfer upon receipt of invoice.

Commission

Commission earnings

Tour operators earn their GuideGunnar commission fees from guest no. 1.

Commission rate is as set out in the signed Tour Operator contract.

Post tour invoiced Tour Operators can track their commission earnings through the booking platform user profile.

Commission payments

For day tours, the commission fee is deducted from the initial and one invoice.

For tours lasting more than one day, the commission fee is deducted from the final payment invoice. That is, the deposit payment of 25 % of the tour fee is paid in its full value.

Commission rates are subject to the following terms

Tour Operators are required to include a GuideGunnar's tour page on their Tour Operator web site which links back into GuideGunnar's site https://guide-gunnar.no.. Tour Operators are required to provide GuideGunnar with the link address (url) to their site's GuideGunnar tour page. GuideGunnar links back to Tour Operator's web site from guidegunnar.no

Participants or their Tour Operator are invoiced for a deposit of 25% of the tour fee, payable by bank to bank funds transfer or by card through the booking platform at time of booking.

Participants or their Tour Operator are invoiced the remainder 75% of the tour fee 45 days before the tour date, payable no later than 30 days before the tour date by bank to bank funds transfer.



Cancellation and refunds

Day- and night tours

10 days: 100 % of the tour fee, less bank transfer costs is refunded you should you cancel your booking 10 days prior to your tour date. 5 days: 50% of the tour fee, less bank transfer costs is refunded you should you cancel your booking 5 days prior to your tour date. Less than 5 days: No refund is granted for cancellation later than five days prior to your tour date. No show: No refund granted on no-show without prior notice to GuideGunnar.

Package tours

45 days: 100% of the tour fee, less bank transfer costs is refunded you should you cancel your booking 45 days prior to your tour date In the event that GuideGunnar cancels the tour, due to poor weather, difficult driving conditions or other causes out of GuideGunnar's control which prevents Guide-Gunnar from arranging the tour, the entire tour fee will be refunded, less bank transfer costs.

Force Majeure

Please note that the landscape in and around Tromsø and Northern Norway is rough, featuring steep mountains in a maritime environment exposed to at times extreme winds. The weather in Northern Norway can be very harsh, and sometimes these weather conditions comes out of nowhere, such as in the event of polar low pressures. No one can predict where and when they will hit. That means the program for day-, night-, and package tours can be changed by short notice, due to these conditions. While GuideGunnar is in no control of these conditions, he works diligently by planning, as well as keeping a constant eye out on weather and road conditions to make your experience as safe as possible. A trip is never canceled due to poor weather in itself. Cancellations only take place in the event of dangerous driving conditions.

The program may be changed, or cancelled in the event of other unforeseen events causing safety concerns, such as road closures caused by landslides, ferries canceled due to wind and extreme conditions in tour locations. World health issues that the WHO (World Health Organization) publishes are also outside GuideGunnar's control and deemed a force majeure condition of these terms by which GuideGunnar is not to be held responsible.
